



2019/2020 Queen Elizabeth Schulich Leader Nomination Application



Below are the steps to apply for nomination for the Schulich Leader Scholarship worth \$80 000-\$100 000. Each BC High School can only nominate one student to apply for this award. All the pieces to this nomination application are **due by Noon on Monday December 16th**

1. Before applying for this nomination, make sure you meet the requirements for this scholarship:
 - a. Applying to SFU, UBC, Uvic or other major universities in Canada or Israeli (check Schulich Leader website www.schulichleader.com)
 - b. Graduate high school in the 2019/2020 academic year
 - c. Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident
 - d. Plan to enroll in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, or Maths)
 - e. Not planning a career in medicine
 - f. Meet at least two of the following criteria:
 - i. Academic excellence
 - ii. Leadership (community, business or entrepreneurial)
 - iii. Financial need (Students planning to apply for government assistance for undergraduate study at university)
2. Visit the Schulich Leader Scholarship website and read about the Scholarship to make sure you understand the scholarship and you feel you meet the criteria (a review of the website will be helpful for your essay!)

3. Visit the Career Centre to pick up your QE External Financial Award Package application.
4. Complete the following questions/essays and submit to Ms. Becker (becker_d@surreyschools.ca) or Mr. Lendvoy (lendvoy_j@surreyschools.ca) **December 16th, 2019**
 - a. Please list the 2 of the 3 criteria you feel you meet for this scholarship (if all 3 apply list on 3):
 - i. Academic excellence
 - ii. Leadership (community, business or entrepreneurial)
 - iii. Financial need (Students planning to apply for government assistance for undergraduate study at university)
 - b. In a written statement of maximum 600 words write an essay demonstrating why you would make a great *Schulich Leader*
 - c. If you listed 'financial need' as one of your above criteria, write a 200 word essay outlining your extenuating circumstances or financial need
